    - iii) Will be requesting a second professional opinion through Mark Mills
      - (1) The civil engineers added unnecessary things to the plan
      - (2) The cost of the second civil engineering plan should come in much less.

    - i) Placed on home page and Site Plan page
    - ii) We have received two donations in April for a total of \$140.
    - iii) Money held by PayPal until we direct them to transfer it to our bank account.
    - iv) We need to make it clear that if the monies are for the building fund, to add a note.

- b) Replenish Tracts

- c) More Divine Liturgy and special service booklets
  - i) Not enough copies for guests
  - ii) Need more copies of the special service booklets; not enough for the choir, let alone the congregation.
  - iii) Invite people to purchase copies
  - iv) Purchase special service books for the congregation (Meg)
  - v) Purchase additional Liturgy books (Fr. John will research)
- d) Upgrade wiring
  - i) Existing wiring is insufficient for our needs
    - (1) Popping circuit breakers
    - (2) Limits our ability to plug in crockpots, hot plates, use the microwave, etc.
  - ii) Ungrounded, two-conductor wiring doesn't meet code
    - (1) Fellowship Hall
    - (2) Children's room
  - iii) Need to talk to Bayview United to see if they will approve it and possibly pay for it. (Fr. John will talk to Jerry about it)
  - iv) If Jerry approves, we'll get a couple estimates and figure out who pays
- e) Mother's Day breakfast
  - i) Flowers to give away (carnations)
  - ii) Mother's day breakfast will not have this year
    - (1) The week before bake sale
    - (2) May 10<sup>th</sup> will be a big wake for Ed Campbell
